**Event 1**

**Participation:** The event involved 76 citizens; 32 participants from the city of Dagda (Latvia), 20 participants from the city of Lupeni (Romania), 24 participants from the city of Pest County (Hungary);

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Locri, Gerace, Roccella Jonica (Italy), from 07/01/2020 to 10/01/2020.

**Short description:** The principal thematism of the event was dedicated to the: "The future of Europe after the elections of the new European Parliament; the role of the EP in the Community context. The international event has prevue the involvement of young people of secondary schools of the town of Locri, international delegation of the project and external expert from CIME (IT), University of Cosenza IT, European Commission. During the event there were citizens of the town of Locri local enterprises, and journalists.

We have had more than 250 local participants. During the event has been assured a simultaneous translation from English to Italian language, this service has helped the participation from many citizens.

**Press Conference** took place in the secondary school of Locri "Scientific Lyceum Zaleuco" with the participation of local media and journalist and young people

**Dialogue** between the partnership of NET4EU with Young people of local schools and some experts of the national academic world over the theme "The new EP after the elections and the role of the European Parliament for the future of Europe"

**Study Visit** to the project financing in the local territory by European found particularly: The archaeological site of Locri; the old town of Gerace and the touristic port of Roccella Jonica etc.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to organize the restart of the activities, after the covid19 pandemic crisis, in the different countries involved in the project. The leader partner specifies the necessity to share the new calendar for the events and to begin by January 2022 the share the contest of the project for the young people that would be concluded until the end of the project in November 2022.

### **Event 3**

**Participation:** European Debate The event involved 80 citizens, 36 participants from the city of Locri (Italy), 20 participants from the city of Dagda (Latvia), 24 participants from the city of Lupeni (Romania),

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in **Budapest, Ocsa, Godollo (Hungary), from 14/09/2022 to 17/09/2022.**

**Short description:** The aim of the international event was dedicated to European debate on EU Green Deal- Preserving our environment. The international meeting took place in Bolyai Janos Secondary Grammar School in Ocsa; During the conference has been organized a short session in which every partner gives a compact 5-minutes (maximum 4-5 Power Point slides) presentation in English introducing their most important nature reserve areas and, on their activities, connected to environment and climate protection related to European Green Deal.

**Dialogue** subsequent the Open forum: “The European Green Deal and focuses on protecting of natural heritage and the landscape, an interactive school program dealing with European Green Deal and focuses on protecting of natural heritage and the landscape (EU 2030 Biodiversity Strategy and Europe's green recovery); Have been participated to the event 100 local citizens, the young people, local journalist, and the local Association of the Ocsa city.

**Press Conference** During the second day has been organized the press conference to present the project to local media and regional TV with the participation of journalist and local media in the location of the Municipality County Hall.

**Study Visits (3 study visits):** in the afternoon of the second day the partnership have visited the EU funded project to Ócsa Outdoor Museum; in the third day there were the visit to Gödöllő a town 30 from Budapest and to the project realized by EU funds by the Szent István University / Gödöllő and to the Royal Castle of Godollo; the last day visit to the center of Budapest and the work in act thank to European found.

### **Event 4**

**Participation:** The event involved 76 citizens, including 36 participants from the city of Locri (Italy), 28 participants from the County of Pest (Hungary), .12 participants from the city of Lupeni (Romania) etc.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Dagda (Latvia), from 24/10/2022 to 27/10/2022;

**Short description:** The aim of the international event was to discuss about the Euroscepticism, its impact on further EU development. During the first day the study visits to the center of Riga by international delegation; every evening was organized a multicultural dinner by the local host organization.

**the meeting:** took place during the second day to the municipality of Kraslava Dagda with the participation of Parish Association and local institutions here the partners discussed over the development of the different territories.

**International Conference** The project partners have discussed over the Euroscepticism, its impact on further EU development. Insight into the latest Eurobarometer survey on Euroscepticism.

**Study visits** (during the 4 events has been organized 3 study visits) to the local project financed by European funds: Youth centre/church/Tourismus center and to the Brewery "Murza", one of the very few small breweries in Latgale. Offers quality beer for lovers of both traditional taste and new flavors. Currently has three varieties of beer, but it is planned to expand the assortment as soon as possible. At the end of the conference there was the visit the Jaundice Nature Trail, in the afternoon the visit to the Crafts Centre in Krāslava; Workshops of ceramists Valdis and Olga Pauliņi During the first day the study visits to the center of Riga by international delegation.

### **Event 5**

**Participation:** The event involved 56 citizens, including 24 participants from the city of Locri (**Italy**), 16 participants from the County of Pest (**Hungary**), 16 participants from the city of Dagda (**Latvia**).

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Lupeni (**Romania**), from 09/11/2022 to 12/11/2022

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to discuss about "Fake news and other defies for the stability of the European Union". During the first day the Steering Committee of the project gathers at Lupeni town-hall to set the details about the final meeting and to organize the general conference in Brussels (contribution and proposal of each partner). The participants discuss about Activities carried on by the local Work group and for the international contest and over the Status of the dissemination activities.

**International conference** opened with the Welcoming from the Mayor of the Municipality of Lupeni at the Cultural Palace in Lupeni; the Artistic show presented by students from the school no. 3 - the singing of the European anthem; then a Brief presentation of the Municipality of Lupeni and the Welcome and contribution by every delegation. Public debate with the contribution of participants and partners of the "Network for a new Europe". Survey – Project discussion and Closure – with the participation of students and teachers from School No. 3 Lupeni and Lupeni Theoretical High School. Taken place to the event must of 100 local young people, students, citizens and Associations.

### **Event 6**

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to launch a contest for video-storytelling about the personal vision about the theme: "My personally idea of Europe; with EU or without EU" – Project Net4EU - Program "Europe for Citizens" - Network of cities; The contest was been launch in each country with a presentation in the secondary schools, university, young campus for involve young people in it and explain to their the rules for take part in the contest. During the local presentation

of the contest in the schools and university the activities involved indirectly more than 200 students. The winners were involved in the final trip to the European institutions at the last meeting.

### **Event 7**

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Bruxelles (Belgium), from 28/11/2022 to 29/11/2022

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to discuss in the international contest with the involvement of the representants of Committee of Region about European migration policies in the future of the EU: Next Generation EU. During the meeting in the site of the Committee of Region, Batiment Jacques Delors, the representant of the delegation present the local situation over the thematic in their country; the intervention of some expert Speakers by ECR Mr Karacsony Adam, from Hungary and Mr Giuseppe Varacalli from Italy give the point of view of the ECR over the "Legale Migration in Europe; and over the necessity to attracting skill and talents in the EU contest. During the event participants can view the video storytelling produced by young winners of the contest. The closure was dedicated to the future of the Europafor citizens program with a contribution over the news program CERV by Mrs Martine Parmentier
